### Photographer curriculum

**Fabio Cuttica** was born in Rome in 1973, the city where he now resides after having lived for more than fifteen years in South America.

In 1996 he moved back to Italy on a permanent basis where he attended the photography course at the Istituto Europeo di Design in Rome, from which he graduated in 1999. In that same year he started working as a photographer for the news section of some national newspapers.

He became part of the staff of the photo-journalistic agency Contrasto in 2001, dealing mainly with social issues.

Since the year 2000 he has been working intensively in America Latina telling, through a series of reports, about the crisis in Argentina, the first football World Cup qualification of Ecuador, Lula s Brazil, the Mapuche fight in Chile; at the moment he is involved in documenting the political and social changes which Venezuela is undergoing and the difficult living conditions in Colombia after more than forty years of armed conflict.

For more than two years he worked on a project about the housing emergency in Italy, reporting how difficult the situation is for many Italian families; this project called "La prima cosa" received the first prize at the "Canon giovani fotografi 2005" awards.
